Discipline Policy

Strike 1 Teacher warning and behavioral redirect.

Strike 2 Private teacher/student conversation to reiterate behavioral expectations and to issue a **final warning** before the student is given a referral by the teacher to be signed by the parent or guardian. (Parental Contact at this time).

Strike 3 Teacher refers the student to the Assistant Principal. Security removes the student from the classroom. Teacher documents and retains a "Low Level Referral Form", completes an "Office Referral Form" and submits the "Office Referral Form" to the AP by the end of the period (no exceptions). Teacher makes contact with parent/guardian by the end of the day.

Classroom Policies & Procedures:

- 1. Students should enter Mr. Mazur's classroom quietly and begin writing down the agenda in their planners followed by working on the day's (BQ) BELL QUESTION.
- 2. Sharpen all pencils and have all materials out at the very beginning of class.
- 3. The first 5-10 minutes of class, students should not talk while working on their agenda and warm up assignment.
- 4. When a student wants to get Mr. Mazur's attention, he/she should raise his/her hand and wait to be recognized.
- 5. Every student is given 6 bathroom passes per year; i.e. 2 passes per Trimester.
- 6. If students need to leave Mr. Mazur's classroom for personal reasons or they are chewing gum in class, they will lose one of their bathroom passes.
- 7. Students may not use **RED** or **COLORED** ink (other than black or blue pen) when they do their assignments; if they do, it will be returned to them to redo and will also be considered late. Students may not turn in half sheets of paper as an assignment (torn in half).
- 8. When students are doing group work, if Mr. Mazur finds 3 students not working, the class will not be allowed to talk for the rest of the class period.
- 9. Absolutely no foul language used in my classroom. Use of foul language for whatever reason will result in a lunch detention and a phone call home. Foul language will not be tolerated for any reason!
- 10. Students can make up each **Test** once in order to improve one's score after school on Mondays. Tutoring is also offered after school on Mondays from 2-2:30pm upon request.
- 11. If a student is absent, he/she is allowed the same number of days as he/she was absent to make up any missed assignments. Please fill out a late assignment form. There is a designated area in the classroom to find any extra worksheets, forms or assignments that may have been missed during the week. Students can find out what they missed by accessing the class website. Late work will not be accepted after being late for more than two weeks.

Grading:

- 30% Classwork/Homework
- 35% Quizzes & Tests
- 35% Labs & Projects

Extra Credit: I do not assign extra credit on an individual basis; however, I do give ample opportunity for students to earn extra credit. Here are a few examples:

- Bring in a box of tissue, hand sanitizer, refillable scotch tape rolls or other class/lab supplies (10 points towards HW, limit one per trimester, item must be pre-approved by Mr. Mazur)
- Positive behavior and a strong work ethic will earn the students the opportunity for additional extra credit throughout the school year.
