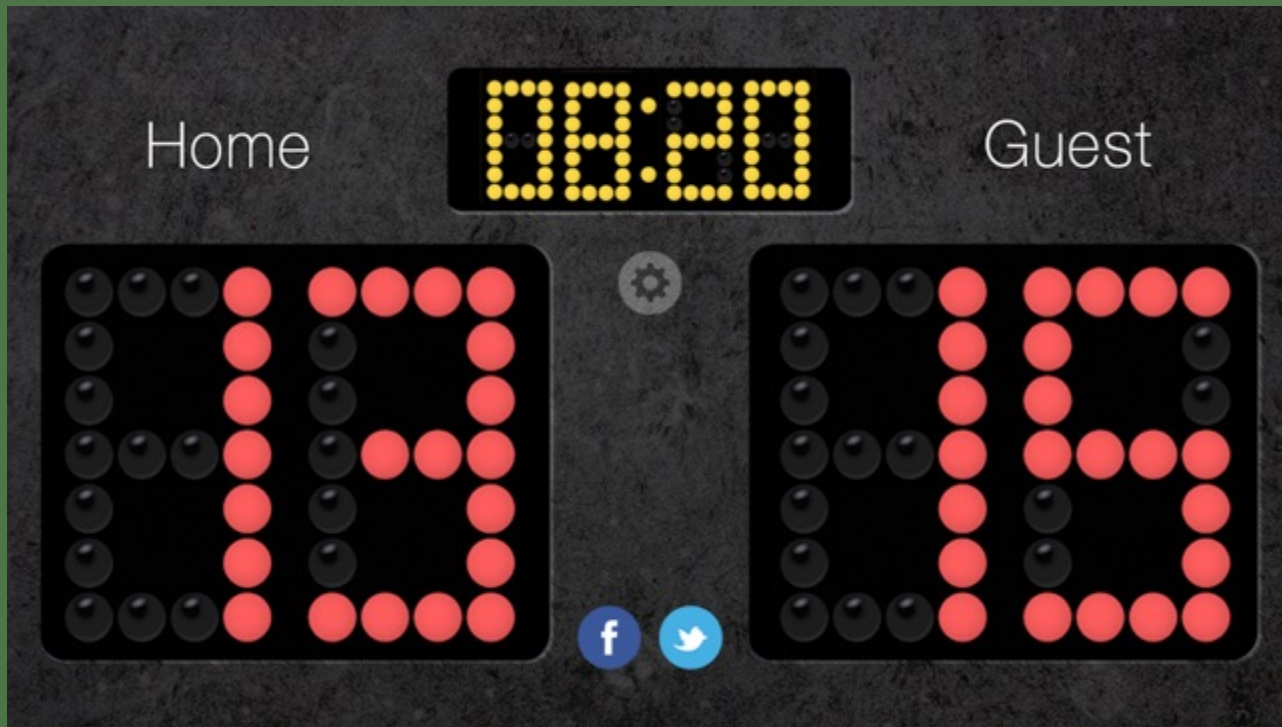

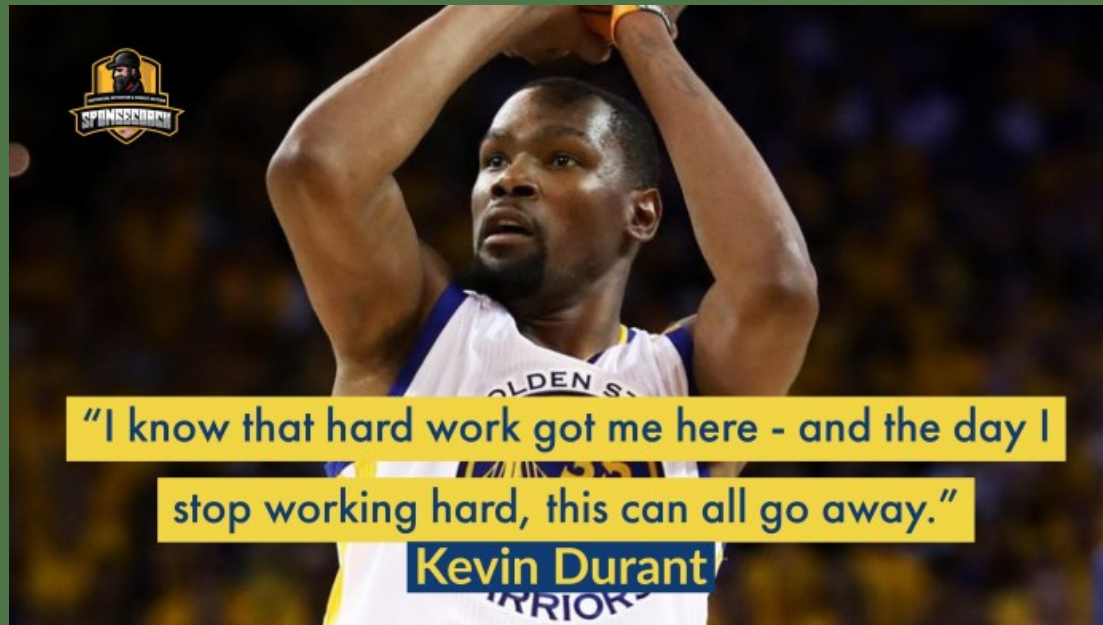

# My Expectations for you

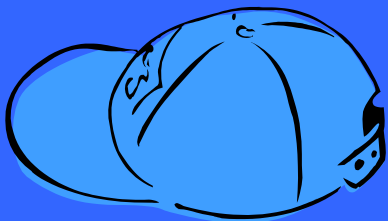
**4. Act responsibly and respect the classroom.

5. Follow all school rules as outlined in the student handbook. This means:

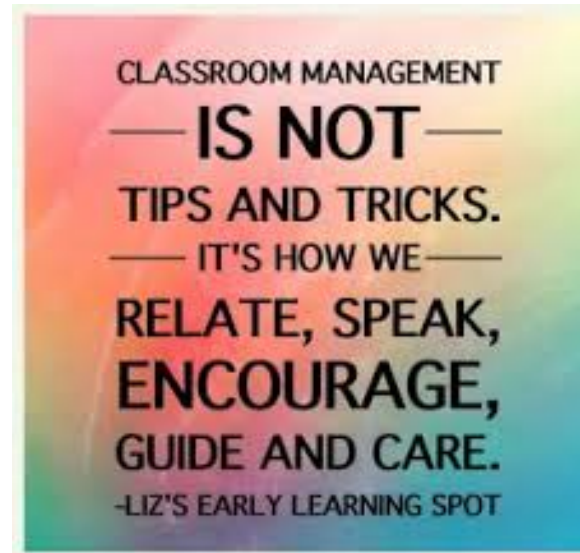
- You must follow rules regarding cell phones, clothing, etc. I fully support the rules outlined by the school.



# Managing the class...

The first help I'll need is adherence to the classroom rules, if they are not followed correctly, consequences will occur:

- 1.Oral warning. Anytime I speak to you to redirect your activity--that is a warning.
- 2.Name on board. (will speak to you after class, or ask to speak to you privately at your desk or at the door.)
- 3.Two checks--10 minute after school detention with me and parent contact by phone or e-mail.
- 4.Removal from class, and suspension. ***Your parent may be required to meet w/me (and I prefer during class) before your return.***

# Passes

# Class Incentives

# Late work

- Must use a late homework pass (Bathroom Pass).

the total points possible.

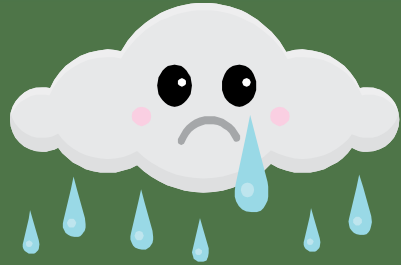
A = 90 - 100 %
